Exam Guidelines by Method

A-1 Domestic Students 'Two-Subject' Method

1. Eligibility

Those who were born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2009 and meet one of the following

- (1) Expect to graduate or have already graduated from a domestic junior high school in March 2024.
- (2) Expect to complete or have already completed nine years of school education in Japan or abroad.
- (3) Expect to graduate in March 2024 from a Japanese junior high school overseas designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, or have already graduated from such a school.

A-2 Domestic Students 'Recommendation' Methods (Exam Rounds 1-3)

1. Eligibility

Those who were born between April 2, 2006 and April 1, 2009 and meet one of the following

- (1) Expect to graduate or have already graduated from a domestic junior high school in March 2024
- (2) Expect to complete or have already completed nine years of school education in Japan or abroad
- (3) Expect to graduate in March 2024 from a Japanese junior high school overseas designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, or have already graduated from such a school

English Recommendation method

Applicants must possess at least an EIKEN Level 3 Proficiency Certificate awarded by the Eiken Foundation of Japan, or its equivalent.

Self-Recommendation method

Applicants must be highly motivated to engage in volunteer activities that contribute to society, and must submit the required essay within one week.

**Note: applications for the Self-Recommendation must be submitted <u>at least two weeks prior</u> to the first day of the application period. (Further, within one year after enrollment, students are required to pass the EIKEN Level 3 or above.)

- (1) Expect to graduate or have already graduated from a domestic junior high school in March 2024
- (2) Expect to complete or have already completed nine years of school education in Japan or abroad
- (3) Expect to graduate in March 2024 from a Japanese junior high school overseas designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, or have already graduated from such a school
 - * Returnees are applicants who have lived abroad for a total of 10 months or more in the past 3 years. Or, for a total of 2 years or more in the past 7 years. (Evidence required.)
