Audrey Faith McGraw, known (1)\_\_\_\_\_ as Faith Hill (born September 21, 1967), is an American country singer, known both for her commercial (2)\_\_\_\_\_ and her marriage to fellow country star Tim McGraw. Hill's voice (described as both soulful and raspy) and careful song (3)\_\_\_\_\_ have helped her to sell more than 35 million records and (4)\_\_\_\_\_ eleven number-one singles on the Country charts.

Hill used her 1999 tour to support a national children's book drive. Fans who (5)\_\_\_\_\_ books at one of her concerts were entered into a drawing to meet her personally after the (6)\_\_\_\_\_. The effort resulted in the donation of 35,000 children's books, which were distributed to hospitals, schools, libraries, and daycare centers in 40 cities across the United States.

In the days immediately (8)\_\_\_\_\_ Hurricane Katrina, Hill and her husband, who was raised in Louisiana, joined groups taking supplies to Gulfport, Mississippi.
